Total cost for the District would be \$35,210.28 with an approved donation of \$20,000 from the Volunteer Association. We previously approved \$225,000 for both a water tender and replacement of 6581. With this plan the total for both would be \$186,810.28. Currently we have \$1000 deposit on the 2005 International chassis. President Giovanatto expressed appreciation to the Volunteer Association for the generous donation.
